PUBLIC HOLIDAYS AND PROHIBITION OF BUSINESS ACT [CHAPTER 292]

Declaration of Public Holiday and Prohibition of Business

THE President hereby, in terms of section 2 and 3 of the Public Holidays and Prohibition of Business Act [Chapter 292], declares that—

- (a) Thursday, the 1st May, 1980, shall be a public holiday;
- (b) no business shall be conducted on the 1st May, 1980, which could not be conducted in terms of any agreement, determination or employment regulation in force in terms of the Industrial Conciliation Act [Chapter 267], were the 1st May, 1980, an industrial holiday for the purposes thereof;
- (c) any business which is conducted on the 1st May, 1980, in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (b) shall be conducted subject to any agreement, determination or employment regulation in force in terms of the Industrial Conciliation Act [Chapter 267] as if the 1st May, 1980, were an industrial holiday for the purposes thereof.
