APPRENTICESHIP TRAINING AND SKILLED MAN-
POWER DEVELOPMENT ACT [CHAPTER 266]

Preliminary Notice: Building Industry: Amendment of
Conditions of Apprenticeship

IT is hereby notified, in terms of subsection (4) of section 16 of the Apprenticeship Training and Skilled Manpower Development Act [Chapter 266], that the Minister of Manpower Planning and Development proposes to amend the provisions of Statutory Instrument 717 of 1979.

The purport of the amendment is to increase the minimum wages payable to apprentices, with effect from the 1st September, 1982, as follows:

<i>Year of apprenticeship</i>	<i>Minimum weekly wage-rate</i>

First	30,60
Second	38,25
Third	55,25
Fourth	72,05

A copy of the notice embodying this proposal is open for inspection at the office of the Registrar of Apprenticeship.

Any interested parties who may have any objections to the proposed amendment may lodge such objections, in writing, with the Apprenticeship Training and Skilled Manpower Development Authority, P.O. Box 387, Harare, within 30 days from the date of publication of this notice.
