PROTECTED PLACES AND AREAS ACT [CHAPTER 11:12]

Declaration of Protected Places

IT is hereby notified that the Minister of Home Affairs has, in terms of section 5 of the Protected Places and Areas Act [Chapter 11:12], issued an order declaring the premises of the Chimanimani Restricted/Reserved Area to be a protected place.

The extent of the area so declared is more fully described in the Schedule to this order. The area shall be surrounded by a security fence and warning sign posts shall be erected. Visitors will be issued

with visitor's passes and a visitor's register shall be maintained at the gates.

SCHEDULE

AREA DECLARED A PROTECTED AREA

Chimanimani Restricted/Reserved Area

The area of land situated in the Masvingo and Harare Mining districts, as denoted and defined by an orange line commencing at a point which is approximately 21,0 kilometres north-east of Birchenough Bridge which is at the confluence of the Save and Odzi rivers (grid reference 36KVP364136); thence proceeding in a north-westerly direction along the eastern bank of the Save River for a distance of approximately 46 kilometres to a point which is at the confluence of the Save and Muroti rivers (grid reference 36KVP126486); thence proceeding on a true bearing of approximately 34° for a distance of approximately 32,6 kilometres to a beacon on Nyarumwe Mountain (grid reference 36KVP308760); thence proceeding on a true bearing of approximately 123° for a distance of approximately 40,4 kilometres to a point (grid reference 36KVP644537); thence proceeding on a true bearing of approximately 193° for a distance of approximately 44,0 kilometres to a beacon on Dzianike Range (grid reference 36KVP544108); thence proceeding on a true bearing of approximately 280° for a distance of approximately 18,2 kilometres to the starting point.
